

## MCI Resident Leadership Academy Guest Speaker Video Instructions & Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in being part of the MCI Resident Leadership Academy. As a guest speaker, we are asking you to record a 5–7-minute video in which you share the following information:

- Your name, Title & Organizational affiliation
- Where were you born? What is your connection to Los Angeles? to MCI network?
- What impact do you want your work to have in the community?
- How did you get interested in the lesson topic?
- What do you want leadership academy participants to know about this topic?
- Do you have a favorite resource on this topic to share (organization, website, etc.)?

Some guidelines to consider for your video recording are:

- 5-7 minutes in length
- Make sure to have good lighting
- Position yourself so you appear on the left side of the screen rather than the center.
- If you are using a phone, film horizontally. You can also record your video using Zoom.
- Wear solid colors, no stripes or patterns
- Record in a quiet room.
- Bilingual speakers can record one video in English and are invited to create an additional video in Spanish, Korean or any other language spoken in our network.
